**Fritz's' Riesling, Fritz Hasselbach, Rheinhessen, Germany**

Off-dry, with a balancing acidity, notes of melon and lime and a touch of ripe fruit. Perfect with food with a little spice or chilly as well as fish.

**Nasco di Cagliari DOC 'Iselis', Argiolas, Sardinia, Italy**

Wonderfully aromatic. Cooked apple and peach character married with notes of almond, cream and a hint of vanilla.

**Sauvignon Blanc Adelaide Hills, Murdoch Hill, South Australia**

Vibrant with notes of aromatic stone and tropical fruits on the nose. Clean and crisp palate of gooseberries and citrus fruits, followed by delicate acidity and a complementing mineral finish.

Perfumed white flowers with lively citrus acidity and flavours of fruit salad.

**Chablis, Domaine Marguerite Carillon, France**

Typical mineral laced citrus and stone fruits flavours but with a ripe fruit element that fill the mouth and provides a lasting flavour.

**Lolo' Albariño, Rías Baixas, Galicia, Spain**

Notes of green apple and lemon peel and a hint of stone fruit. Fresh, zippy fruity palate and a fullness to match richer flavoured food.

**Marsanne La Belle Aude, Borie de Maurel, Minervois, France**

The palate has a rich mouth-feel with savoury and stone fruit flavours backed by floral notes. Ideal for fish, white meats, cheese and vegetables.

**[TH] Sauvignon Blanc 'Terroir Hunter', Lo Abarca, Undurraga, Chile**

Bright lemon-green colour, mangetout aromas with fresh limes, grass and hint of petroleum. Bright and vivacious with crunchy green fruit flavours. Citrus finish - wonderfully crisp.

Fruity nose with sweet notes of strawberries and fresh cherries. Best matched with savoury dishes or with mushrooms.

**Merlot/Grenache, Les Vignes de L'Eglise, Languedoc, France** £4.75      £18.50

Cherry red in colour, with fresh, perfumed aromas of ripe plum and berry fruits.

### Dryer style with a touch of oak

**Château Montcabrier, Bordeaux Supérieur, France** £24.00

Made with Merlot and Cabernet Franc with flavours of dark cherry, blackcurrant and plum and soft tannins.

**Cabernet Franc, Sainte Marie des Crozes, Pays d'Oc, France** £7.50      £29.00

Deep ruby colour and complex floral, blackcurrant and raspberry fruit aromas. Sweet, ripe fruit and fine subtle tannins finishing with notes of caramel.

**Château des Bardes, Saint-Émilion Grand Cru. Bordeaux, France** £42.00

Classic Merlot dominates this blend with Cabernet Sauvignon making up the balancing. Aged in oak barrels which produce rich, fruit aromas; juicy, sweet tannins backed by soft touches of vanilla-toastiness.

**Ripassa Valpolicella Ripasso DOC Superiore, Zenato, Veneto, Italy** £10.50      £45.00

Intense ruby red in colour. Solid texture of polished tannins and ripe fruit with berry, chocolate and black tea. Full bodied, dry with plenty of fruit yet reserved and pretty.
